1. Call to Order
2. Pledge
3. Principal's Update
 - a. Testing this month – 2 days per week
 - i. Email with testing schedule being sent out
 - ii. There will be a modified schedule during the school day and adjusted bell
 - iii. Approx 60 previous OLA students returning to in-person in 4th quarter – requiring more use of MS rooms, MS finding other spaces for testing such as HS
 - b. Maria Schneider named Shape Midwest Regional Health educator of the year – 1 of 4 national finalists – congratulations!
 - c. Latest quarantine rules
 - i. Close contact can be tested on the 5th or 6th day following exposure, if negative then can return to school after day 7
 - ii. If no test, then return after 10 days of quarantine
 - iii. Follow the dates that are given when student is quarantined
 - iv. If student submits a positive test for antigens, no quarantine needed for 90 days following due to exposure
 - d. 3rd quarter grades will be posted to Progress Book
 - e. OLA students returning in 4th quarter means some shuffling to keep classroom numbers in line, affects 8th graders more since higher number returned for that grade.
 - f. Some activities returning to somewhat normal; HS is having a Spring musical, spring concerts are on the calendar, Kick it activities are being planned.
 - g. Still determining how Academic recognition will be handled this year
